

## **Directions to Montana de Oro and Horse Camp**

**From Highway 101 (either coming from the North or South) through San Luis Obispo, take the “Los Osos Valley Road” exit.**

**Go West (you will pass car dealerships, a large shopping center on your left with a Costco and another center just past the intersection of Los Osos valley Road and Madonna Road on your right with a Shell station that has Diesel). Stay on Los Osos Valley Road through the town of Los Osos ( the town is about 8-10 miles or so from the freeway turnoff). Continue on this road (it changes names at the curve and will narrow and become two lanes) up the hill to the park (the ocean will be on your right and clearly visible).**

**Once you enter the park at the top of the hill, the entrance to the horse camp is on your left, almost immediately after you enter the park.**

**The entry road is single lane and unpaved. Drive slowly and take your time.**

**At the bottom of the hill is Oak camp on your right, and if you are in Madrone camp you must also turn right.**

**The remainder of the camps are accessed by continuing straight at the bottom of the hill to their turnoff road.**
